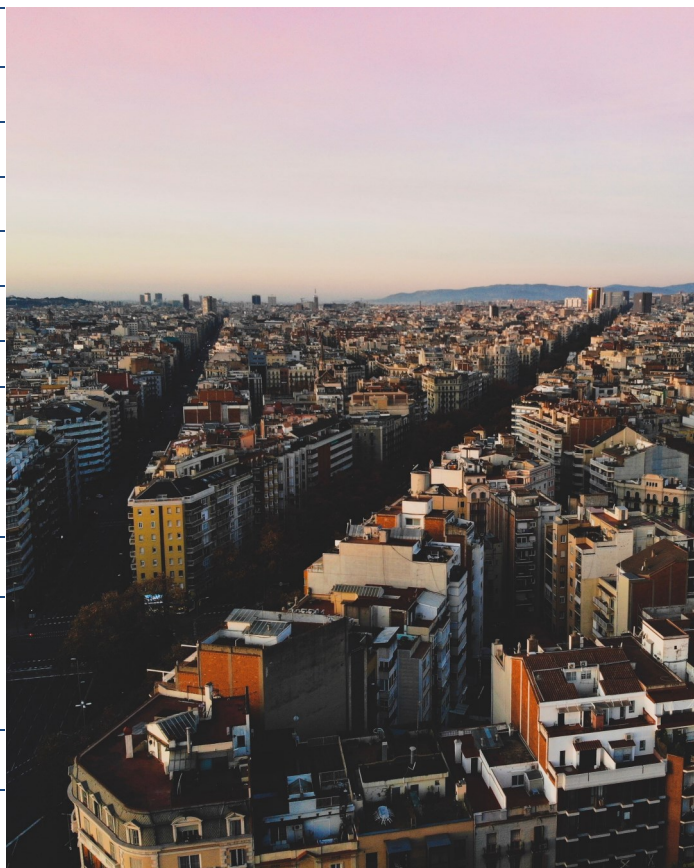

### Description

Universitat de Barcelona, consistently ranked within the top 5 Universities in Spain, was established in 1402 as a Medical College. It now accommodates over 80,000 students at campuses across the inner city, and welcomes 2,000-strong incoming exchange students each year. ### How to apply

When successfully selected by UWE and nominated to UB, you will need to:

- Complete and print an online application form
- Submit a language certificate of B1 Spanish or A1 Catalan (applicants will be given access to UWE's online language support system to support and assess their language learning).
- Post original copies of the above with a confirmation certificate from UWE's Study Abroad team and 2x passport photos
