Description

Malmö is a young, modern university set right in the heart of the city next to the harbour and Central station. Almost all of its buildings have been recently built. It is a multi-disciplinary university where subjects are often taught holistically, combining different areas of research to cover a topic. Malmö university welcomes over 300 exchange students annually. Its active ESN network organises social events for exchange students to aid their integration into student life.

Surrounding Area

Malmö is Sweden's third largest city and is located in the south of the country. It is only a 20 minute train journey away from Copenhagen in Denmark and a 4 hour train journey away from Stockholm. A mix of Dutch renaissance architecture and unapologetically modern buildings on its waterfront, this multicultural and progressive city is home to over 150 nationalities.

Accommodation

Exchange students are given priority for university accommodation. Private accommodation is limited and students are advised to start looking early. Private rents cost around £400 per month.

When successfully selected by UWE and nominated to Malmö you will need to provide: Selection of courses form, nomination form, personal Statement & Transcript of grades, ID Document, completed online application. Application deadline: 15th April
