Description

NCAD is located in the heart of Dublin's historic Liberties neighbourhood and is unique in offering Ireland's widest range of programmes in Design, Fine Art & Visual Culture.

Incoming exchange students are encouraged to participate fully in studio departments as well as in Visual Culture lectures and seminars and benefit from access to a range of services including the Students Union, College Doctor and Counsellor and Learning Support where necessary. A 12-week class introducing Visual Culture in Ireland offers incoming exchange students an opportunity to meet regularly and to visit places of interest beyond the NCAD campus.

Surrounding Area

Dublin is Ireland's capital and largest city. It is a historical and contemporary centre for education, the arts, administration, economy and history and has a significant literary history. The Liberties is a



historically working-class neighbourhood in the southwest of the inner city, now a location for art galleries, theatres, bars and music venues. The area is host to the Liberties Festival, one of Ireland's oldest festivals encompassing visual art, film, dance, comedy, literature and music.
