Description

Surrounding Area

Seoul is the capital of South Korea and the Korean peninsula's largest metropolis. It is home to approximately half of the country's population of 50.22 million people and contains five UNESCO world heritage sites. Seoul also has major transport links to all other Asian countries and other international locations.

Accommodation

University Accommodation is available for 170 students on campus in various blocks with rental

studio apartments available for some male students. Expect to pay around £250-350 per month, and budget an additional £400 per month for personal expenses.
