TERMS OF REFERENCE

Purpose

The purpose of the Strategic Workshop Sessions is to provide an opportunity for student representatives, Governors and members of the Executive to discuss and engage in the student voice, key strategic themes facing UWE Bristol, and national initiatives that will impact on the student body. Where appropriate, the issues discussed will be at a relatively early stage of development so that the debate can inform the University's policy and approach.

Deputy Clerk to the Board of Governors (or nominee)

University and UWESU Officers as are required to assist with the business of the meeting, by invitation.

The Strategic Workshop Sessions are open to all Members of the Board of Governors and the Students' Union Trustees to contribute to discussions. Members of the Board are encouraged to attend at least one session per year.
