

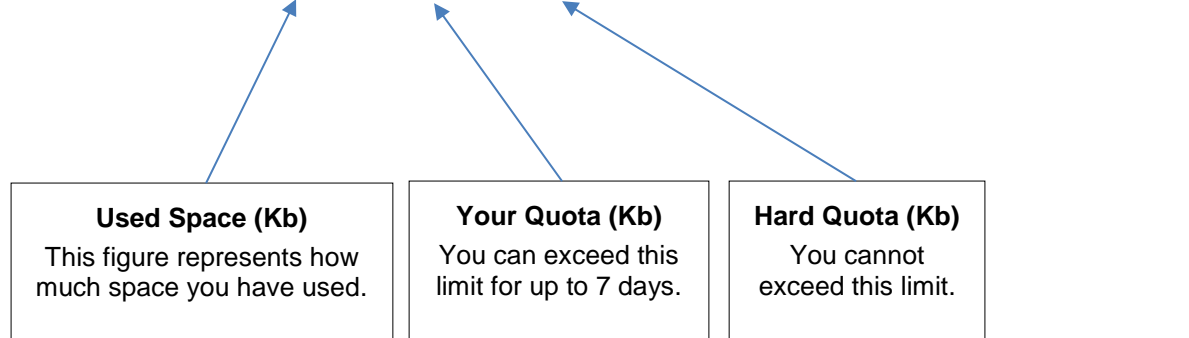
Linux Disk Quota

To avoid going over your allocated disk quota, please check how much disk space you are using by typing:

```
quota -v
```

The screen will display how much space you have used and how much you have been allocated, eg

```
milly:~$ quota -v
Disk quotas for user <username> (uid <uid>):
Filesystem blocks  quota  limit  grace  files  quota  limit  grace
/nas        1193752 15728640 15885926
```



Note:

- If you have exceeded your quota you have 7 days to remove files, however you cannot physically go over the hard limit.
- You will not be able to use a graphical login, e.g. gnome if you are over your quota.
- Use `putty` from a Windows machine to connect to milly and remove files.
