## **UWE Bristol DBS and Safeguarding Arrangements for Initial Teacher Education (ITE) Programmes**

All ITE trainees are rigorously assessed against the following criteria prior to being placed in school:

- Evidence of appropriate access qualifications that meet the entry requirements of the course (see admissions page)
- A clear Enhanced DBS Disclosure including check of Children's barred list. https://www.gov.uk/government/organisations/disclosure-and-barring-service
- Two satisfactory references submitted during the application to the programme

- Verification of identity and right to work in the UK
- Check for sanction, restriction or prohibition on teaching issued by the Teaching Regulation Agency (TRA) (if in teaching role)

## The university will also check that candidates are not:

- subject to a prohibition order issued by the Secretary of State;

- or have obtained a childcare disqualification waiver from Ofsted. (fee paying students only)
