PROFESSIONAL BEHAVIOURS and RESPONSIBILITIES
(seven key aspects)

PASS

FAIL

PLACEMENT FAIL
A FAIL overrides a PASS in LEARNING DOMAINS

10 LEARNING DOMAINS (LDs) under 3 AREAS
ALL LDs must be passed to PASS the placement

Personal Development

1. Independent learning
2. Seeking, reflecting on and responding to feedback
3. Organisation and prioritisation

Interpersonal Skills

4. Communication
5. Working with others
6. Individuals, communities and populations

Decision Making and Implementation

7. Gathering and analysing information
8. Evidence-based practice
9. Reasoning and intervention
10. Recording information

LEARNING OUTCOMES (LOs) - 3 LOs within each LD

- FAIL **one LO** within one LD = **PASS/40% or above**
- FAIL **two or more LOs** within one LD = **FAIL/below 40%**
- FAIL **up to three LOs** across different LDs = **PASS/40% or above**
- FAIL **four or more LOs** across different LDs (even if all LDs passed) = **FAIL/below 40%**

LEARNING OUTCOMES (LOs)

- Award a % banding for each LO within a LD (see CPAF Appendix 2: Assessment Criteria full rubric)
- Weighting: Educators make a professional judgement regarding weighting of 3 LOs based on knowledge of setting (see p.15 of practice guidance)
 - Add PASS/FAIL and % marks to the 'Final Assessment Summary' (p.29 of CPAF)
 - Total and divide by 10 for overall placement mark
