

Why have you chosen this course?

What have you done that **demonstrates** your interest?

How are your academic subjects relevant?

What **skills** have you developed that **show** you have the aptitude?

80-90% academic focus
(this includes work experience)

10-20% extra-curricular
(part-time job/sports/hobbies
etc.)
