Ashton Gate Stadium - Travel Details

METROBUS

- metrobus m2 route Ashton Gate stop is just 450m walk away. Links us with Long Ashton Park & Ride, City centre and Bristol Temple Meads via direct service
- metrobus m1 route Parson Street stop is just 14 minute walk. Links us with Cribbs Causeway, north Bristol and south Bristol

BUS

- 24 to City centre, nearest stops immediately outside both entrances
- X1 and x2 to Weston-super-Mare stop approximately 200 meters
- X3, X3a and X4 to Portishead stop approximately 200 meters
- X6 to Clevedon stop approximately 200 meters
- X7 to north Somerset stop approximately 200 meters
- X8 to Nailsea stop approximately 200 meters
- X9 to Long Ashton stop approximately 200 meters
- 75 and 76 to north and south Bristol 14 minute walk

RAIL

- Nearest station: Parson Street with connections to Nailsea, Weston-super-Mare, Taunton, Exeter and Bristol Temple Meads – 15 minute walk
- Mainline station: Temple Meads with direct connections to London, Cardiff, Birmingham 40 minute walk, 10 minute taxi or metrobus m2

TAXI

- 10 minutes to City centre
- 10 minutes to Bristol Temple Meads

CYCLING

- 96 bike cycle hub
- 10 YoBike parking spaces

WALKING

• 30 minutes to City centre

AIR

- Bristol Airport is England's third largest non-London airport
- Airport Flyer A1 stops at the Ashton Gate metrobus stop and links us directly to the airport (20 minutes) and central bus station (16 mins). Currently suspended due to Covid-19 so I have attached the standard map/timetable
- A2 stops at Parson Street, 14 minutes away. This service is still operating

ROAD

A370 Long Ashton bypass, A4 Portway and A38 Bridgwater Road all run past the stadium

PARKING

- On site
- Overflow parking at Wickes if required
- Other overflow parking can be found on request in locality
- Long Ashton Park and Ride is just 20 minutes walk away or two stops on the metrobus m2

EVENT SPECIALS

 Ashton Gate runs event day special buses for football, rugby and concerts. Concerts saw over 6,000 people arrive and depart by bus for the Spice Girls and Take That
