LET'S GO

Start at the Info Point in Reception – our main access point for student support services. It's in the B Block foyer, just next to the north car park.

B Block is where you'll find our easy-to-access student hub, which is home to mental health, employment and academic support services.

Come out of the Info Point and turn right exiting the building through the double doors. Head straight in front of you towards the doors marked with a C. You are now in C Block.

Turn right here and continue along the corridor, you'll see a number of specialist print making facilities and studios.

These include:

- **Digital printing, fine print and 3D print rooms**
- **Textiles**

Exit through the double doors directly at the end of the corridor and turn left. The wooden building directly in front of you is G Block which hosts the following facilities:

- **Film studios**
- **Production studio**
- **Two large photography studios**
- **Stop motion animation and CGI studios**
- **Sound recording and Foley sound effects studios**
- **Colour grading studios**
- **Editing suites**

For security reasons these facilities are only accessible with a UWE Bristol identity card or a visitor swipe card.

Retrace your steps back and head left under the covered walkway through the door, which takes you into F Block.

Along this corridor you'll find the Digital Design Studios – the main IT suite. This is split into four rooms – all with Macs featuring the latest design software.

Before entering these rooms, please check for an open access sign to indicate no teaching sessions are in progress. If you see this sign, feel free to go in and look around.

Towards the end of the corridor is the newsroom.

Exit F Block at the end of the corridor by using the large doors on the right hand side. Keep walking forward and you will see D block on your left. Here you'll find flexible workshop spaces, communal areas and the following facilities:

- **Fabrication, casting and ceramics studios**
- **Integrated Foundation in Art, Media and Design**
- **Interior Design**

For security reasons you can only access these facilities with a UWE Bristol identity card or a visitor swipe card.

Continue forward past D block, heading towards the stairs or ramp that will take you up on to a patio area outside A Block. When you walk into the A Block building, you will see the Students' Union area and the main student hub seating area. Here you'll find The Hub restaurant where you can stop off for a drink or quick snack if you like.

Continue through the Student Hub and turn right, heading back towards the Info Point. To your left, just before you go past the campus coffee shop, you'll find our largest drama studio.

Opposite the Info Point is the art shop. Here, students can buy a wide range of art, media and design consumables from specialist paint materials to data storage.

If you turn left by the art shop, this will take you to a stairway which leads to the Library. Go through the doors and turn right to enter the Library.

When you arrive at the Library, please let reception staff know that you're a visitor.

In the Library you'll find both individual and group study areas. Laptops are available to borrow and there's an extensive DVD library with a selection of art-house films.

Leaving the Library, walk back through the corridor to the lift and staircase.

If you'd like to see the rest of B Block, you'll find:

- **Photography on Level 3**
- **Fashion on Level 4**

To finish the tour, head back down the stairs to the Info Point. Please pop in and see us if you have any questions at all.

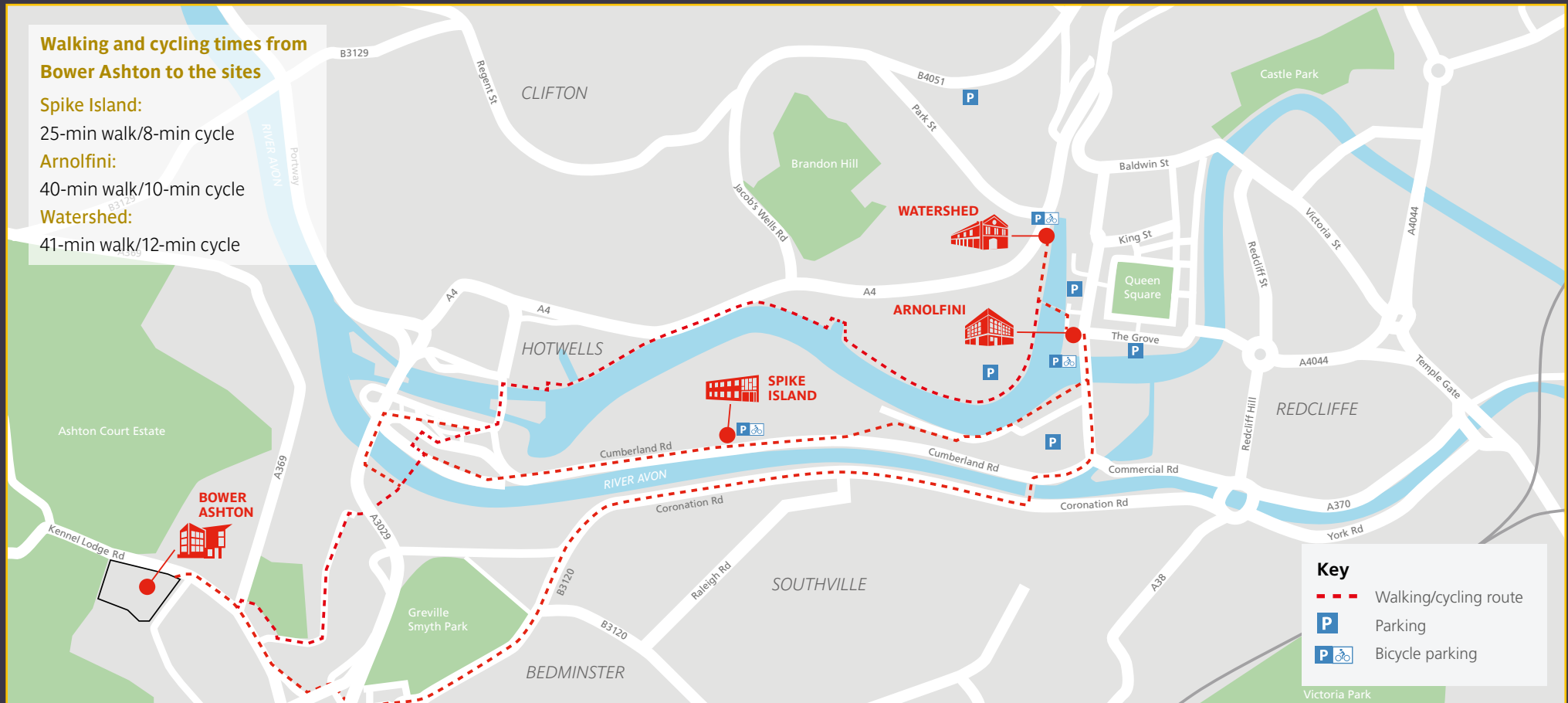

BOWER ASHTON
