Description

The Academy of Arts, Architecture and Design, Prague has origins dating back to 1885. It was the first and only state art school in Bohemia when it was established. The school is comprised of 5 practical departments containing 23 studios, each led by an expert in the field.

Surrounding Area

Prague is the capital and largest city in the Czech Republic. The city boasts more than 10 major museums, theatres, galleries, cinemas and other exhibits. It has a modern public transport system and a low cost of living, making it very popular with expats. There are quick and easy links by train to Berlin, Vienna, Budapest, Zurich and other European destinations.

There are 75 rooms available in accommodation for exchange students. Students are also able to find their own shared accommodation privately with other students should they wish.
