### Description

The University for Arts was founded in 1947, and became a fully-fledged University in 1998. It is composed of 4 'Institutes' – Arts and cultural studies, Art and Design, Media Studies and Space and Design. Departments here work across a wide remit – Painting & Graphic Art, for example, also incorporates performance, and is particularly Fine Art focussed especially in philosophy and models of practice.

The Austrian city of Linz is situated in the North of Austria, not far from the borders with the Czech republic and Germany. On the banks on the Danube, this city draws tourists to its Castle, newly-opened Opera house, Museum of Contemporary Art and Electronica Centre which exhibits technology and digital art.
