### Description

PXL University college is located in Hasselt, Belgium. Their Arts campus is walking distance from the charming centre of Hasselt, where students can enjoy cafes, shops and much more. PXL's Media, Arts and Design (MAD) faculty offers students the opportunity to study object & jewellery design (including gold- and silversmithing), as well as graphic, illustrative, interactive, advertising design and fine arts (sculpture & installation, ceramics, painting, printmaking or open lab).

### Surrounding Area

This historic, fairy-tale like small city is known in Belgium as a centre of fashion, and is home to many museums; a Japanese Garden and many more attractions. Events are common in the city's squares throughout the year. Not far from Hasselt lies also the magnificent Open Air Museum of Bokrijk. Student life centres around Dipenbeek, 10 minutes by bike from Hasselt. Hasselt is well

connected by train to Paris (3 hours), Amsterdam (3 hours) and Brussels (1 hour).

### Accommodation

Accommodation is privately arranged with support from University staff. Rent in Hasselt is between EUR200-700/month with the average rent of a small room being around EUR260/month.

### How to apply

When successfully selected by UWE and nominated to PXL University college you will need to complete an online application consisting of a completed application form, learning agreement, CV, transcript, and an electronic artistic and personal portfolio with a minimum of 20 images of personal creations.
