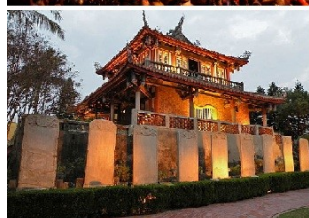




## Tainan University of Technology

### Description

TUT is located in the Yongkang District of Tainan, a 30 minute bus journey from the city centre. The University has over 80 partnerships with Universities abroad and welcomes a small number of exchange students from these institutions every year.
