Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU) is a public research university based in Tokyo. Every year it welcomes over 100 students from 30 different countries around the world. Exchange students register in the Semester Abroad at TMU programme and are able to take over 100 courses in English as well as Japanese language courses. Students who have level N1 Japanese language skills are allowed to take courses in Japanese.

Surrounding Area

Tokyo is the capital of Japan and one of the largest cities in the world with the 'Greater Tokyo Area' having a population of over 37 million people. Cost of living is said to be the highest in the world but there are 100 Yen stores for you to buy cheaper items if required. Tokyo is due to host the 2020 Olympics in summer 2021 and is also home to a thriving anime culture.



Accommodation

There is limited university dormitory accommodation available on campus. Support is available to find private rental accommodation, but rents in Tokyo are very high and it can be challenging to find if you don't speak Japanese.
