Description

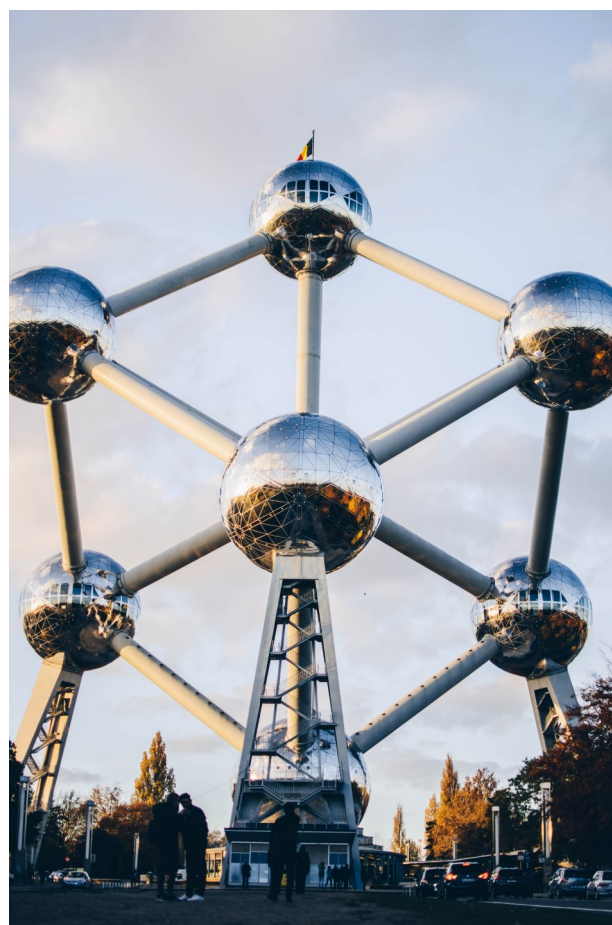
Vesalius College is a small college founded by the in 1987 by Boston University and the dutch-speaking Free University of Brussels, or *Vrije Universiteit Brussel*. It is one of the few educational institutions in Belgium that teaches exclusively in English.

Its campus is next to Vrije Univesiteit Brussel's main campus and two institutions share facilities including a library, cafeteria, sports complex and gym.

Vesalius takes a humanistic approach to intellectual inquiry, encouraging students to not only learn skills and knowledge important to their chosen careers, but to think critically and develop themselves personally and as citizens of an increasingly multicultural and globalised world.

Surrounding Area

Brussels can arguably be described as the entre of European culture and institutions. It is home to the
