### Description

Universidad de Alicante is one of UWE Bristol's longstanding exchange partners. The University has an active Erasmus Student Network (ESN) in Alicante that organises trips and activities for exchange students. Typical modules studied in Alicante include architectural composition, urban planning, and computerised design.

### Surrounding Area

Students arriving in the dynamic, attractive, provincial city can expect frenetic, typically Spanish nightlife and excellent weather. Many examples of historic architecture such as the Baroque Casa de La Asegurada (1685), the most ancient civil building in the city. Today it is home to the Museum of Contemporary Art of Alicante.
