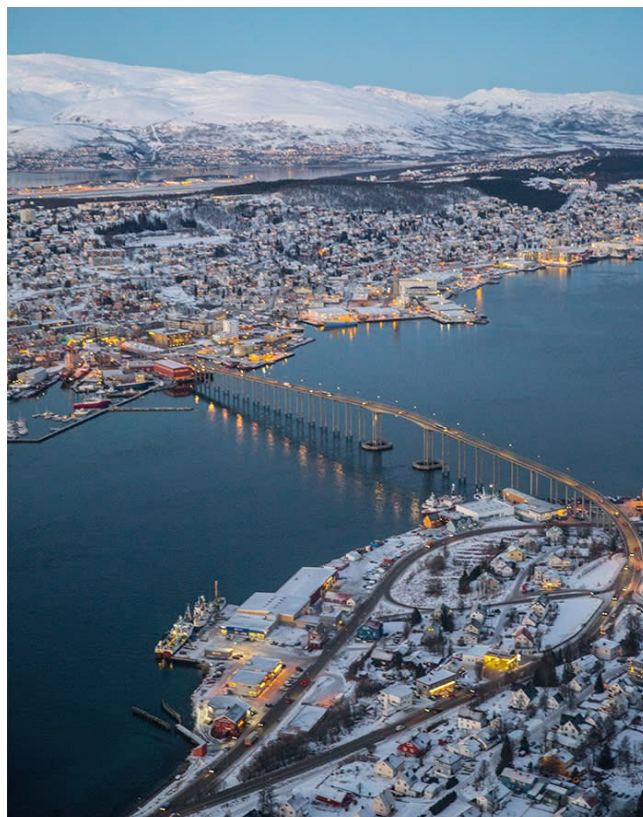

Description

The Arctic University of Norway, also known as Universitetet i Tromsø, is the Northern-most university in the world and is located well inside the Arctic circle. Students undertake clinical placements in a hospital setting whilst on exchange allowing them the opportunity to gain specialist skills in a professional healthcare environment outside of the UK.

Surrounding Area

Tromsø is a small town with a population of just 64,200 (2013). It is a cultural centre for the region and there are several festivals that take place during the summer. The 2 main sections of the city are connected by the Tromsø bridge that is visible from all parts of the city. Students will be able to experience everything from 24 hour sunlight in the summer to prolonged periods of dark in the winter. There is also the chance to see the Aurora Borealis!



Accommodation

Students will be sent a personal code to apply for accommodation once they have submitted their main application. Accommodation is not guaranteed so and early applications are recommended.

- Submit a draft Traineeship agreement, transcript and copy of your passport via the online portal
