### Description

Nursing students at this institution will undertake clinical placements on exchange allowing them the opportunity to gain specialist skills in a professional healthcare environment outside of the UK. Erasmus students are guaranteed accommodation, and offered an airport pick up service, as well as a buddy programme and number of social events.

### Surrounding Area

Bergen is the second largest city in Norway. It is known as 'the gateway to the fjords' and is surrounded by mountains. It has a cool, oceanic climate and plentiful rainfall. Bergen hosts culture and film festivals annually, and is the street art capital of Norway.

### Accommodation

Accommodation is guaranteed for semester one students who apply by 5th May. There are a variety of accommodation options available for students at

different price points but students will have to pay for the full semester even if they are not staying for the full period.
