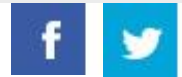

Council Tax

As a final year student your council tax exemption has now ended (or will come to an end on the last day of your placement). If you have resits, you'll still be liable to pay council tax – you won't be exempt.

If after your resits you need to retake the year, an extension certificate will be available in myUWE, and you'll be repaid any council tax you have paid over the summer.
