Extenuating Circumstances deadline for resits

Please be aware that if you decide to go ahead with an assessment, you're making a judgement that you're fit to do so and the mark you achieve in that assessment will stand.

You may apply for [Extenuating Circumstances](#) if something major affects your ability to submit coursework or attend an exam.

Normally you cannot apply for Extenuating Circumstances for assessments you have done – however there are two exceptions where you may submit an application – in these cases if your application is accepted the mark you achieved for the assessment will be removed.

If you are planning to submit Extenuating Circumstances, please note the deadline is **Friday 29 July, 14:00**.

Please talk to an Information Point for advice as soon as you can – ideally before submitting an application.
