
In case you missed it...

We will send your award certificate to your **home address** (not your term-time address). Please check it's up-to-date on the myUWE Addresses tab. If it's not right, make sure you update it before your results are published.

While you're in myUWE, please check your other personal details are up-to-date too.

Update your details

Remember to download your documents

You'll lose access to university IT systems 42 days after your course finishes – this includes myUWE, Blackboard, your H Drive and OneDrive.

Make a note to download anything you may want in the future – like your [Higher Education Achievement Report](#). It's best to do this once you've received your results.

We're refurbishing Traders this summer

We're starting work on the refurbishment of Traders next week! From September you'll have more space for group work as well as a new café area.

We are setting up a temporary catering service in 1H16 from Monday 19 June, where you'll be able to get a selection of hot and cold meals, sandwiches, snacks and drinks. This will be open Monday - Friday from 08:00 - 15:00.

Relocation of IT computers and equipment
