Anatomy.tv is an interactive 3D anatomy resource. It has views of the head and neck, spine, hand and forearm, shoulder, thorax and abdomen, pelvis, hip, knee, leg, foot and ankle.


Each anatomical structure is presented in fine detail, and includes surface anatomy, nerves and arteries. Also included are common pathologies, radiological content, interactive quizzes and multiple choice questions.

Accessing Anatomy.tv


You can find Anatomy.TV by browsing our list of library databases:
