


How to Access the Q&A Service for the NPPF Level 2 or National Investigator's Exams

2. Check that you are accessing via UWE e.g:

4. Choose the Q&A service you wish to access and click on the link.

5. If you are a first time Q&A user, please enter login details Email: UWEBristol and Password: policeaccess in the panel to your left on a computer or tablet, or at the bottom on a mobile phone.
6. Doing so will bring up the 'Register' link in the menu bar at the top. Click on Register.

7. Enter your name, your UWE Bristol email address (you must not use a personal email), and create your own password, then click on the “Register” button

8. If you click on the “Register” button and the screen goes blank (i.e. you get a completely white screen). Don’t worry! You have registered correctly.
9. Close down your browser windows.
10. Reopen your browser and go back to: [Blackstone's Police Manuals](#)
11. Check you are using UWE Bristol access.
12. Scroll down to the Q&As, and click the link to access.
13. Use your newly created login details and click on the “Sign In” button.
14. You should see something similar to the image below, and the remaining days left on your subscription.
