On your own device, launch via Cloudpaging Player
Follow the steps below

V-ray for Revit will launch using Cloudpaging Player.
Please note, this app is not available for Mac.

Step 1

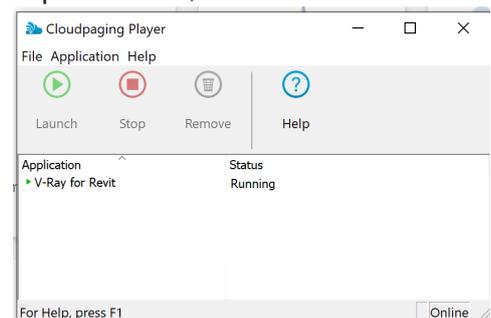
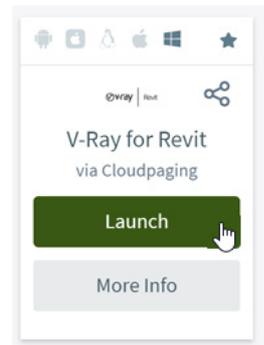
Go to <https://appsanywhere.uwe.ac.uk>, log in, and look for V-Ray for Revit, click **Launch** to activate Cloudpaging Player.

Step 2

Cloudpaging Player will advise 'V-ray for Revit' was added to your list of applications'. The player will show 'Pre-fetching', 'Activating', then 'Virtualising' up to 100%.

Step 3

The app will open, and you can start work, while Cloud Paging Player continues 'Paging the remainder' up to 100%, then shows as 'Running'.



On a UWE computer, V-Ray for Revit is installed locally.
Launch via AppsAnywhere.
