Student Supervision

Information for Service Users/Patients

This information sheet outlines the ways in which student physiotherapists are supervised. If you have agreed to be assessed/treated by a student physiotherapist please read the information below.

A student physiotherapist may be supervised by one or a number of qualified physiotherapists. The level of supervision may vary depending on the student's stage of training and it could take various forms including some or a combination of the following:

- Direct observation (constant or intermittent)
- Supervision in the same room / clinical area / cubicle
- Pre and post assessment discussion with the supervisor
- Pre and post treatment discussion with the supervisor
- Treatment planning and agreement
- Checking and counter-signing of written documentation
- Supervision/feedback sessions at specific times (for example at the beginning and end of the day)
- Shared supervision with other team members
- Telephone supervision

You are entitled to ask to see the supervisor at any time during your course of treatment.
