Description

Dankook is a private university located in Jukjeon, south-east of Seoul. It was the first private University established after Korean independence in 1947 and has a strong reputation as an incubator for future entrepreneurs. It has active exchange partnerships with hundreds of Universities across the world. The College of Art and Design is on the Jukjeon campus, around 45 minutes from the centre of Seoul.

Surrounding Area

Jukjeon has good transport links into Seoul, the Korean capital and the peninsula's largest metropolis. Seoul is home to approximately half of the country's population of 50.22 million people and contains five UNESCO world heritage sites. Seoul also has major transport links to all other Asian countries and other international locations.

Accommodation

Double-occupancy (shared) rooms on campus are mandatory for exchange students and cost around £950 for the full semester. Meals are provided but kitchen use is permitted upon request. Students offering to lead conversation classes in English are eligible to apply for free accommodation.

When successfully selected by UWE and nominated to Dankook University you will need to provide:

- Online application
- Transcripts & Study Plan
- Passport photos & Scan of passport
- Certificate of Insurance
- Medical certificate of TB screening
