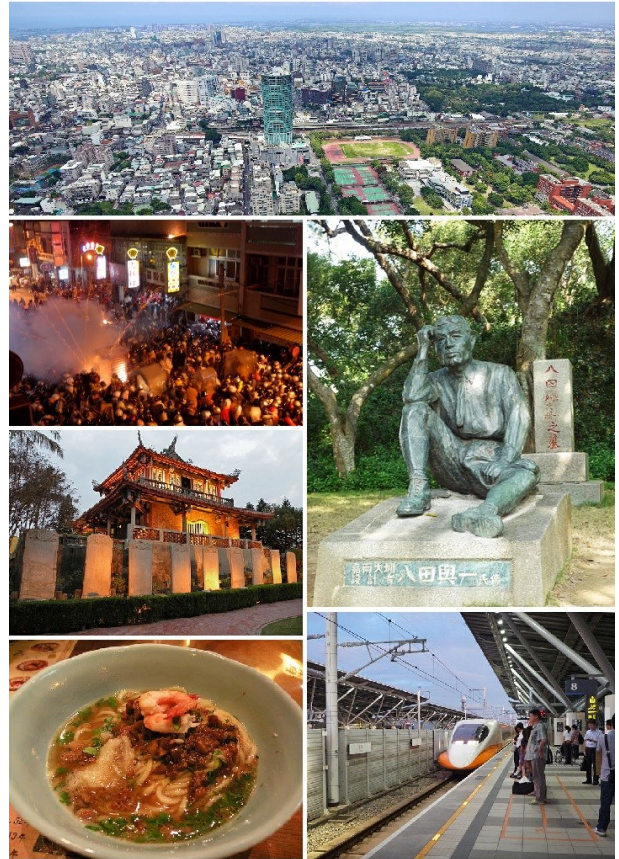


# Kun Shan University for Filmmaking and Animation

Students will need to complete a health examination upon arrival in Taiwan (approx. cost £78)
