Description

SHU was founded in 1956 by journalist and publisher, Mr. She-Wo Chen. Originally an institution for training professional journalists, it became a comprehensive university in August 1997. SHU has four colleges and two language teaching centres and teaches Journalism and Communication, Management, Humanities and Social Sciences, Law, English Teaching and Chinese Teaching. SHU has been named one of the few “Teaching Excellence Universities” by Taiwan’s Ministry of Education since 2005.

International students make up 8% of its student population and it is partnered with 170 universities worldwide.

Surrounding Area

Taiwan’s capital city is home to 2.7 million people. The city has a thriving performing arts scene and shopping district with both modern shopping malls and traditional night markets. Annual festivals in-

clude the Lantern Festival, Lunar new year and the Dragon Boat Festival.

Accommodation

2 or 4 person shared rooms cost around £950 for the semester. Rooms are furnished with beds, reading desk, drawers, bookshelf, wardrobe, air conditioner, TV, refrigerator, internet and a private bathroom.

How to apply

When successfully selected by UWE and nominated to SHU you will need to submit an application form, together with a recommendation letter from UWE, a transcript, passport copy, health certificate and passport photo.
