# Description

Rennes School of Business is a global School of Management in France in Brittany. All of its programmes are taught in English and 50% of its students are international. It is has a network of 260 partner Universities worldwide and triple EQUIS, AACSM and AMBA accreditation.

Despite its relatively small size, the School has a modern and well-equipped campus boasting social facilities, a cafeteria, language laboratory, library and gymnasium.

Rennes School of Business operates an airport pickup service at the start of term from nearby airports and train stations.

### **Surrounding Area**

Rennes is an ancient medieval city in the heart of the picturesque province of Brittany in north west France. The tenth largest city in France, it is a significant digital innovation centre home to 63,000 students. It is 1.5 hours from Paris by train and 1

hour's flight from London. Brittany is well known for a coastline that includes dramatic clifftops and rock formations as well as secluded sandy bays.

#### Accommodation

The University's own student accommodation is just 5 minutes from campus. Private accommodation options include shared flats, studio, home stay or state student hostels. Expect to budget between EUR350-500 per month including bills.
