Description

The University of Zagreb is the oldest and largest University in South-Eastern Europe, offering education and research in all fields at all levels. Their Erasmus Student Network (ESN) and International Office organise social and welcome events including sessions on history and culture during welcome week. The Faculty of Economics and Business has 8,000 students from Undergraduate to PhD level and its own library, sports facilities and restaurant. The faculty welcomes around 175 exchange students each year.

Surrounding Area

Zagreb has culture, arts, music, architecture and gastronomy—all the ingredients for a quality capital city. The city has a population of around 800,000. Its 'old city' has architecture reminiscent of Vienna, Budapest and Prague. Picturesque medieval towns can be found nearby, and the famous Plitvice lakes are around a 2 hour drive.
