Surrounding Area

Istanbul is the largest city in Turkey, constituting the country's economic, cultural, and historical heart. Istanbul is a transcontinental city in Eurasia, with its commercial and historical centre lying on the continental European side and about a third of its population living on the Asian side. It's diverse heritage makes for a vibrant, inclusive and expanding community with a cosmopolitan food



scene and city rich in ancient Greek, Ottoman and Byzantine architecture.
