

Description

Collegium Civitas is a modern, private university located in the heart of Warsaw, the most dynamic capital city of Central and Eastern Europe. It offers many courses taught in English including Political Studies, which is the most highly ranked Politics course in Poland.

It has a vibrant and thriving Erasmus Student Network which welcomes new students, helps them find accommodation, organises trips, and aids students integration into University life.

Surrounding Area

Poland's capital stretches across a broad area and is characterized by diverse architecture, restored Gothic, communist concrete and modern glass and steel. Excellent museums interpret its complex story, from the joys of Chopin's music to the tragedy of the Jewish ghetto.

Warsaw's restaurant and entertainment scene is the best in Poland, offering global cuisines and lively bars and clubs.

It has one of the lowest costs of living for students in Europe with rent costing between EUR150-250 a month.

Accommodation

Collegium Civitas does not offer campus accommodation, but their Office of International Cooperation and the Erasmus Student Network (ESN CC) will assist the exchange students in finding suitable accommodation.
