Description

HKBU is centrally located on the Kowloon side of Hong Kong. The University's four campuses are well served by public transport. Government and International Studies programme.

HKBU is one of UWE Bristol's longstanding exchange partners - subject links include Geography and Art and Design subjects.

Hong Kong is a vibrant, diverse city marked by a vigorous blend of East and West and is seen by many as a gateway to the Chinese mainland. It has a vibrant shopping scene with a mix of modern shopping malls and traditional markets. There are
