Description

The University of Ljubljana is one of the largest educational institutions in the world. Established in 1919, the university is made up of 23 faculties and 3 art academies and welcomes 2000 Erasmus students every year. It's student organisation, SOU, provides social help (legal assistance, student services and accommodation help), cultural events, sports and extra curricular activities. The university also has an active Erasmus Students Network (ESN) providing opportunities for sight seeing and social activities.

Surrounding Area

Ljubljana has a young and lively character thanks, in part, to the student population and English is widely spoken by the locals. It is one of the smaller capital cities in Europe but still has many of the amenities such as museums & galleries, theatres and libraries.
