## SQL\*Plus On Oracle

SQL\*Plus is a command line interface into Oracle and it is the user application that ships with the Oracle database. In CSCT & EDM it is available on both the Windows and Unix systems.

## Using SQL\*Plus On The Windows System

- 1. From Start, select All Programs, Oracle, SQL\*Plus. A command window will appear.
- 2. Enter your username@otis, e.g. an-other@otis followed by your password. SQL\*Plus for Oracle will now open.

## Using SQL\*Plus On The Unix System

- 1. From a command line, type sqlplus.
- 2. Enter your Oracle username and password. SQL\*Plus for Oracle will now open.
