



# Your Placement Checklist

# **First Year**

Improve your CV using <u>CV 360</u> on Careers Toolkit.

Increase your chance of getting a placement by taking part in <u>employability activities</u>.

Check InfoHub for any upcoming Careers or Placement events for first year students.

Research what kind of placement you want to do by using the <u>Careers</u> <u>Toolkit</u>.

### **Second Year Continued**

Attend a <u>Placement Briefing</u> to help you prepare for starting work.

Select the Placement module choice and ensure you have <u>enough</u> <u>credits</u>.

> Apply for <u>Student Finance</u>. For guidance contact the Student Money Service.

# **Second Year**

Begin <u>searching and applying for</u> <u>placements</u> from September onwards.

Use <u>InfoHub</u> and websites like Indeed and Rate My Placement to find opportunities.

Access <u>UWE Bristol resources</u> to get help with your application and interview.

You will need to get your <u>Placement</u> <u>Confirmed</u> once you have an offer.

#### Placement Year

- Register as you would normally, you are still enrolled at university.
- Book a <u>Settling in Call</u> with the Placements Team after one month on Placement.
- Engage with your Placement module on Blackboard, you will have deadlines for University Work.
- Make sure you check your UWE Bristol emails as this is how we will contact you during your placement.
